Background

The Department of Fertilisers (DoF), under the Ministry of Chemicals and Fertilizers, Government of India (GoI) is vested with the main objective of ensuring adequate and timely availability of fertilizers at affordable prices for maximizing agricultural production in the country.

The main functions of the Department include planning, promotion and development of the fertilizer industry, planning and monitoring of production, import and distribution of fertilizers and management of financial assistance by way of subsidy / concession for indigenous and imported fertilizers.

In line with the government objectives of Self-Sufficiency, the Government of India is exploring pathways for promoting indigenous production of Green Urea through deployment of renewable energy-based technologies, with a view to enhancing fertilizer self-reliance, reducing carbon emissions, and supporting India's net-zero commitments.



With the above intent, Expression of Interest (EOI) is hereby invited from the interested entities (Project proponent/Technology provider/OEM etc.) for setting up the green urea capacities in India.

For the purpose of this EOI, Green Urea shall broadly mean urea produced using green hydrogen derived through electrolysis powered by renewable energy sources and carbon dioxide obtained from emitting sources. However, innovative alternative pathways resulting in substantially reduced lifecycle carbon emissions may also be proposed by interested entities

Tentative Contents of EoI

The EoI should include but not limited to following:

1. Introduction of Interested Entity and its tentative role in the given objectives.
2. Details regarding proposed technologies, source of feedstocks and utilities
3. Proposed Project Configuration and Economic Capacities
4. Identification and justification of proposed project location(s), including availability of renewable energy resources, water, CO₂ source, logistics connectivity and fertilizer demand centres.
5. Development Model such as: Independent Greenfield Projects, Brownfield Integration with Existing Urea Plants, Renewable Energy Developer-led Projects, Joint Ventures / Consortium Models, BOO/BOT Models
6. Tentative Schedule for setting up of facilities leading to production of green urea.
7. Estimated capital cost

8. Expected levelized cost of Green Urea.
9. Estimated requirement of renewable power, water, green hydrogen and carbon dioxide.
10. Expected carbon footprint reduction vis-à-vis conventional urea.
11. Land requirement and infrastructure requirements.
12. Policy, fiscal and regulatory support required from Government. Respondents may indicate the minimum support mechanism required for commercial viability

Confidentiality Agreement:

Information submitted by interested entities may be used by DoF for policy formulation, feasibility assessment and future scheme design. Submission of EOI shall imply consent for such use. Proprietary information should be clearly identified by the respondent.
